

Rich's Hollow Concert Series

NORTH MONTPELIER – That Celina Moore's home, once the 1805 Rich's Hollow inn, is a home for informal concerts is nothing new. The soprano, known as one of central Vermont's most passionate classical music advocates, has been hosting concerts during her entire 40 years residing there. But, for the first time, she has introduced local musicians to join in a series.

Saturday will see the first of the series when the Kotchka Players perform at 4 p.m., followed by tea and cakes. The Players are pianist Alison Cheroff, flutist Hilary Goldblatt and violinist Ruben Kosemyan.

The program features: J.S. Bach's B Minor Sonata for Flute and Clavier; Beethoven's Violin and Piano Sonata No.


